Golf Tournament - Göteborgs Golf Klubb, Hovås - www.goteborgsgk.org

The traditional Golf Tournament will be held at Göteborgs Golf Klubb, Hovås. The 18-hole parkland course overlooking Gothenburg's southern archipelago, is Sweden's oldest golf club founded in 1902.

Programme Non-golfers - Sightseeing in the harbour of Gothenburg

For non-golfers we are planning a sightseeing tour with an old steamship in the harbour of Gothenburg. On the way we will visit the Volvo museum where the guide will take us on an exciting journey through the history of Volvo. The excursion ends with lunch at Långedrag Vårdshus, situated just outside the harbour with a wonderful view of the archipelago.

Informal Dinner – Feskekörka (Fish Church) - www.feskekörka.se

In the evening an informal dinner will be held for both golfers and non-golfers. We will take you to one of the most characteristic buildings in Gothenburg – Feskekörka. Designed by Gothenburg's former city architect, Victor von Gegerfelt, the building was inaugurated in 1874. In 1910 the fish auction was moved to the new fishing harbour at Majnabbe. Since then the Feskekörka gradually emerged as Gothenburg's leading site for the sale of seafood.

Programme - Accompanying Partners - Gunnebo House and Gardens - www.gunneboslott.se

For the accompanying partners we are planning a guided tour to Gunnebo. Gunnebo House and Gardens is one of Sweden's foremost 18th century facilities and is beautifully situated between the lakes Stensjön and Rådasjön in the city of Mölndal, just south of Gothenburg. We will visit the house and the gardens of Gunnebo where organic cultivation is very important. In the gift shop you will find high quality products associated with the house and its history. Finally, we will enjoy a delicious lunch with locally produced food after which the bus will take us back to the hotel.

AGM Dinner - The Royal Bachelors' Club - www.rbc.se

The dinner will take place at The Royal Bachelors' Club. This building was acquired by ship owner Dan Broström in 1922 and donated to the Swedish Ship Owners' Association by his widow in 1956 subject to the condition that she could use the premises until her death. After her death in 1965 the Swedish Ship Owners' Association realized that it was unable to use the building for modern office purposes and therefore decided to lease it to The Royal Bachelors' Club founded in 1769. The club is rich in history and tradition.
