This building was acquired by ship owner Dan Broström in 1922 and donated to the Swedish Shipowners' Association by his widow in 1956 subject to the condition that she could use the premises until her death. After her death in 1965 the Swedish Ship Owners' Association realized that it was unable to use the building for modern office purposes and therefore decided to lease it to The Royal Bachelors' Club founded in 1769. The club is rich in history and tradition.
